In this position you will play a key role in establishing a supportive relationship with adults living with intellectual disabilities or autism in a setting which provides socialization and community interaction. You will support individuals in the community during inclusive activities promoting volunteerism and community service, healthy living and fitness, increased daily living and personal development skills, and opportunities to connect with and form meaningful relationships with community members. In this program, staff assist each individual with their goals as outlined in their Person-Centered Plan (PCP) and to embrace their ability to be independent.

- Must have High School Diploma or Equivalent.
- Must be willing and able to take courses to become certified as a Direct Support Professional, CRMA, etc. Paid training is provided.
- Ideal candidate is good with people, outgoing, thrives in an active and fast paced environment, works well both independently and as a team player.
- This person must be comfortable supporting individuals with various levels of disability in a variety of different settings.
