Seeking Contractors Shared Living Provider Be Your Own Boss!

Independence Association's Shared Living Program is seeking individuals or families who are interested in becoming Shared Living Providers. Shared Living Providers are willing to share their home and provide a safe, nurturing environment for individuals with intellectual disabilities or Autism. Shared Living Providers are Independent Contractors and are their own boss! Independence Association offer guidance and support to Shared Living Providers through regular home visits, assistance to access required trainings, MaineCare billing, compliance standards, and other assistance needed to do the job well. Independent contractors are paid based on a day rate of \$95.00 in addition to room and board!

Position Requirements

- Ideal provider should have a positive attitude, be flexible, creative, be able to maintain required paperwork and be willing to support individuality and personal growth.
- You must have a High School diploma or GED.
- You must complete required trainings and certifications. Training is paid for.
- Must be able to pass background checks.
- You must have a clean house and a spare bedroom.
- Providers support individuals with day to day activities, accessing community resources and developing relationships that offer opportunities to enrich their lives and strengthen their daily living skills.
